Please note that this update is divided into two sections. The first section, Phase Updates, contains specific information pertaining to particular residents while the second section, Overall Updates, contains important information pertaining to all residents.

PHASE UPDATES

Interlachen Bluff & Interlachen Circle

Grading crews will continue working this week to shape the roadways for paving.

Crews plan on paving Interlachen Bluff sometime tomorrow. Once Interlachen Bluff has been paved, they will move to Interlachen Circle; however, due to timing and scheduling, they may not get to Interlachen Circle until Monday.

While they are paving, you will not be allowed to park on your street. This will help to speed up the paving process. You are not required to park off-site; however, if you wish to do so, residents living on Interlachen Circle may park on Merilane Avenue, while residents living on Interlachen Bluff may park on Cooper Avenue.

Please expect minor delays and access to your driveway while crews are paving your street. The pavement will be placed and rolled immediately. Once it cools slightly, you can drive on it.

Friday's garbage and recycling services will go on as normal. Crews will assist with this service as needed.

Irrigation system and pet fence repairs: If you have not yet scheduled your irrigation system and pet fence for repair, please do so now. Please schedule them for the **last week of June, or the first week of July**. If the repairs are done any sooner the systems could be damaged again when crews are shaping behind the curb. Please keep in mind that the City pays for these repairs only once.

Please have your irrigation contractor mark the irrigation head locations with a flag. This will help sod crews to locate the heads and not disturb them while installing your new sod.

Repair invoices are to be mailed directly to the City of Edina, 4801 W. 50th St., Edina, MN, 55343, attention Aaron Kuznia, Engineering Dept.

Crews intend to begin replacing sod in the neighborhood in about 1-2 weeks.
