Parkwood Knolls Neighborhood Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

Please note that this update is divided into two sections. The first section, Phase Updates, contains specific information pertaining to particular residents while the second section, Overall Updates, contains important information pertaining to all residents.

PHASE UPDATES

Phase 1 - (South Knoll Drive, Knoll Drive, Idylwood Lane and part of Schaefer Road up to Idylwood Lane intersection)

Crews have now completed the paving the first layer of blacktop in your neighborhood. They are currently working on exposing the manholes in the street, paving in the gaps in blacktop driveways, and installing the black dirt behind the new curb and gutter. Crews will be reinstalling the removed mailboxes on your street sometime next week.

Irrigation system and pet fence repairs: If you haven't yet done so, please schedule your repairs now to your irrigation and pet fence systems. Crews plan to begin replacing the sod in your neighborhood late next week, and finish sometime the week of July 12th. Once the systems have been repaired, please have your company mark the locations with a flag. This will help sod crews to locate the heads and not disturb them while installing your new sod.

Please have your irrigation company or pet fence company invoice the City directly @ 4801 W. 50th St., Edina MN, 55343. (Attn: Aaron Kuznia, Engineering Dept.)

In an effort to speed up the project, would you please turn your irrigation zones off that are near the street. If the black dirt is too wet, crews will not be able to work the soil to re-sod your lawn.

Please remember, these schedules are weather dependent.

Phase 2 - (Schaefer Road north of Idylwood, Parkwood Road and Westwood Court)

CenterPoint Energy and its contractor, Michels, will continue working on the gas main on your street. Parkwood Road at Schaefer Road is closed. This closure is between the intersection and all access in and out of the neighborhood will be via Blake Road. Mail, garbage, recycling, etc will go on as normal. CenterPoint Energy anticipates the upgrades being completed in about 2 weeks.
